



Statement on COVID-19 (Coronavirus) - March 14 2020

At Sunridge, we are closely monitoring the evolving situation with the COVID-19 virus. The safety of our guests and staff are paramount in our daily operations and, in-line with Alberta Health Services (AHS) guidelines and regulations, we are taking the following additional steps.

- Increased sanitization, using bleach, of regular touch points in the chalet (sinks and handles, washrooms, drinking fountains, rental equipment and so forth).
- Encouraging customers to regularly wash their hands. Additional signage has been placed in the chalet to emphasize this important safety measure.
- Asking staff and customers to stay home if they are not feeling well or may have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Encouraging everyone to maintain a safe 'social distance' and not to shake hands, to sneeze or cough into your sleeves and other similar actions to minimize potential contact with and spread of the virus.
- Large bookings of over 250 people, such as school field trips, have been cancelled. **We will remain open through Sunday March 15 which will be the last day of the season.**
